CALIFORNIA HUNTER EDUCATION

The Coyote Point Rifle and Pistol Club promotes responsible gun ownership and practices. In our California Hunter Education classes we strive to help develop hunters with a solid grounding in safe gun handling skills, conservation and wildlife management. Students will receive an overview of modern firearms, muzzleloaders, archery, and field safety.

Upon successful completion of the course, students are issued their Hunter Education certificate, which can be used to purchase a hunting license in California. This certificate is valid in all 50 states where a hunter safety certificate is required to purchase a non-resident hunting license. 2010 Spring SCHEDULE

The Coyote Point Rifle and Pistol Club will offer two conventional hunter education classes, this spring. The conventional class is well suited for students that learn in a classroom environment. Generally younger students and those with less firearms/hunting experience do well in the 10 to 12 hours of classroom instruction with some limited homework. Students are required to attend all class sessions. The recommend age limit for the conventional class is 11 years old to ensure a reasonable chance of passing the exam.

NOTE: Pre-registration is required for the class. Registration is limited to 30 students per class. All students must be pre-registered for the class two weeks before the class starts to be guaranteed a slot in the class. All applications received after the deadline will be putting on a waiting list pending space available in the class.

A parent or legal guardian must accompany students under 18 years of age so the necessary consents, releases and waivers can be signed at the beginning of the first class.

The student must answer 80 or more questions correctly from a required DFG 100-question exam (multiple choice) in order to be issued a certificate. We will not be giving makeup exams.
