

# Coyote Point Rifle & Pistol Club

## 2010 Light Rifle Matches

**Dates:** 4th Sunday each month, April through September (April 25, May 23, June 27, July 25, August 22, September 26)

**Location:** Coyote Point Firing Range

**Firing Times:** 7:30am and 8:45am (2 relays)

**Distance:** 50 Yards

**Target:** A-25 (100 yard Small Bore Rifle) and Luck Target

**Fee:** \$7.00

**Equipment:** The rifle to be used shall be any .22 Rimfire rifle weighing not more than 8-1/2 pounds including sights: as manufactured or modified from a rifle weighing originally not over nine pounds. Schutzen-type butt-plates, slings, leather jackets, and shooting gloves will not be used. Either metallic or telescopic sights may be used as long as the rifle remains within the 8-1/2 pound limit.

**Note:** The Club has a limited number of .22 caliber rifles for loan to the members for the purpose of shooting these matches if a member does not have a suitable rifle of his own. Club members borrowing these rifles must sign them out on the log book and will be responsible for cleaning and returning the rifle to the Club Room when finished.

**Classifications:** There will be three classes again this year:

**OPEN:** Any sight

**IRON:** For those who do not wish to compete against those who are using scopes.

**JUNIOR:** For competitors under 18 years of age.

**Rules:**

1. Competition is open to ALL Club members and their guests; (guests must be accompanied by the sponsoring Club member.)
2. All Matches will be fired from the prone position.
3. Matches will consist of two stages of twenty shots each. (40 shots total)
4. Firing Time will be thirty minutes per stage, unlimited sighters included.
5. Luck Target will be posted to the right of the second stage sighter target and ten shots will be fired on it in ten minutes. No sighters on luck target.

**Awards:** As we have done in the past we plan to use the Fly Luck Target as the system to award prizes.

See point system below for prizes and points awarded at each match. Points may be combined over the course of the 7 matches to acquire more valuable prizes. This includes couples combining their points as well.

There must be a minimum of three (3) competitors in a class to qualify for an award in that class.

All competitors that complete a minimum of four (4) matches will be invited to attend a Brunch as their award for attending the matches.
